Can I say two? I love 3D embossing folders and stencils for coloring layers!

#### 9. How do you deal with "crafter's block" or being stuck in a rut?

It happens for sure! If I feel blocked and I have a deadline, first I choose a stamp and/or die set I love! For me, I don't try to visualize a final project. That is when I feel stressed to make it just as I see it in my mind. Then I start by choosing my color palette. I really do try to let go of what I WANT it to look like, and just enjoy the process of working with that set. I would say that 99% of the time, that totally works!
